

# Parent Involvement

▲ 120 mothers and their children 0-5 participated in & benefited from the Motherlode Mothers of Multiples.

■ 60 fathers (or grandfathers, uncles & male caregivers) and their children 0-5 attended the Dad & Me events.

● 119 children 0-5 and their mothers are members of the Mothers' Club of Amador County.



## Father/Male Involvement

First 5 Amador added a focus for father/male involvement strategies in 2005. These strategies are on-going and include: programs such as the development of a public service announcement for radio and television; sponsorships for community partners to attend conferences regarding father involvement; and a planned program that involves Dad and ME events.

# Family Resource Centers

◆ Upcountry and Camanche Lake Community Center's staff assisted parents and caregivers in filling out Healthy Families health insurance applications for 112 children. 99 of those children are now enrolled and have vital health coverage.

## Family Resource Centers

First 5 Amador is committed to ensuring that the county's diverse population of families is served. To reach geographically isolated families, opportunities for support are provided by First 5 in the outlying areas of the county.

● Eleven families received high-quality culturally competent case management at the Family Resource Centers for 6 months. All families demonstrated significant gains, especially in the area of interactive literacy activities.
