A map and directions will be sent upon receipt of registration.

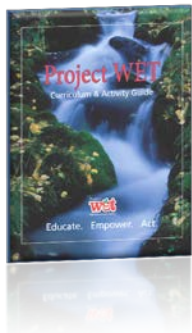
