#### What is Quality for Kids?

Quality for Kids is Amador's local initiative that aligns with the Quality Counts California's goals to strengthen the state's early learning and care system to support young children and their families. You can learn more about QCC here

#### What are Quality Improvement Plan Goals?

Quality improvement goals are identified by you. These goals should reflect the areas of improvement you would like to implement into your childcare program. In order to receive the QIP incentive, you must complete 3 QIP goals. Some examples include:

- Attend 2-hour ASQ-3/ASQ-SE2 training and implementation of ASQs into your childcare program.
- Focus on social-emotional development, nutrition, literacy, math, outdoor learning, etc. that is approved by the Quality for Kids coordinator.
   Completion of this goal will be demonstrated by showing how your focus area has been addressed.
- Attend FCCERS/ECERS training, conduct a Self-Assessment and develop an action plan to include list of materials.
- 25 hours of professional development hours
- Coaching Companion
- Ginni on the Move (Social / Emotional support provided by our Behavioral Spec.)

#### What are Professional Development hours?

Professional development hours can be earned by attending both in-person and online workshops and trainings. In order to earn professional development hours, you must show proof of attendance. ## Program Element

## Participation

- Create Quality Improvement Plan (QIP)
- Create 3 QIP goals approved by Quality for Kids.

### Incentive

- \$250 stipend for completion of approved site QIP and 3 goals approved by Q4K.
- Recognition in Newsletter/Website/Facebook, etc.
- Playground stencils paint or chalk provided.
- Family engagement kits (as available)

 Ages & Stages and Ages & Stages Social-Emotional (ASQ-3 / ASQ-SE2) Questionnaires (Developmental Screenings)

Annual Quality Improvement Plan (QIP)

- Attend 2-hour ASQ-3 / ASQ-SE2 training
- Distribute ASQ's to families, track, provide appropriate referrals, and follow up
- Receive ASQ Questionnaire Kits
- Site support for ASQ implementation
- \$250 stipend for achieving 70% ASQ return rate, per site. Up to 2x per year. To include follow-up on referrals.

#### Ongoing Campaigns:

All Participating Sites

- "Reading Across Amador" Literacy Campaign
- Read to the children in your childcare 20 minutes per day, write the name of the book and color in one of the books on the reading log. Return to Quality for Kids on the 1st of each month.
- \$50 stipend per month (paid on a quarterly basis) for completion of reading logs.

• Professional Development

25 hours Professional Development completed according to Quality Improvement Plan (attending workshops, trainings, etc.)

 \$400 per participant one-time (per fiscal year) stipend upon completion of 25 hours-per Family Childcare Home provider or individual Preschool site teachers.

Coaching Companion

- Completion of Coaching Companion cycles (each cycle earns 2 hours of professional development).
- \$100 per cycle (up to 6 cycles) per participant one-time stipend upon completion of Coaching Companion cycles- per Family Childcare Home Provider or individual Preschool teachers.

- Early Childhood Education (ECE) Units
- ECE Apprenticeship- partnership with Amador
- College Connect

- First Priority: Family Childcare: Complete up to 12 ECE units to quality for Child Development associate teacher permit.
- Completion of Education Plan prior to classes
- Second Priority: Working toward A.A. or B.A or in Child Development. Includes General Ed. college units with emphasis on English and Math.
- \$400 for 3 ECE units, up to \$1600 for completion of 12, working toward Child Associate Teacher Permit
- Pay costs to acquire, maintain or upgrade Associate Teacher Permit
- \$400 for 3 completed ECE units
- Up to \$1600 for units toward A.A. or B.A.
